- WRNP property line and trail path still needs follow up from town –
 ACTION ITEM: Anna to follow up on revocable permit
- Hickory Bark Deck Repair follow up Dead tree removal
 - o Lots of dead trees that need to be removed to avoid a recurrence of damage
 - o **ACTION ITEM:** John to involve Glenn M, Eric, and Steve (Eric's dad) to assess what needs removal
- 6/19 workday at FMCP address wet spots and build boardwalk
 - o Eric will transport lumber from Loews on Saturday morning
 - o Notice to membership went out Monday 6/14
- WRNP: Mowing/New Trail Stewards
 - Steward job description: monitor trails, take care of smaller items, and bring bigger items to attention of the Board
 - New trail stewards
 - o Linda Siple and Tom Gibbons, Green and Brown Trail
 - o Chris Streeter Red Trail
 - Matt Frank no longer to mow WRNP Ron Happ
 - o Mowing required 6 to 7 times/year, taking 5 to 6 hours each time with 61-inch mower, and 5 gallons of gas
 - o Hal suggested follow Crescent Trail model using Silver Fox volunteers.
 - Town drops mower off on Wednesday, and volunteer of the week picks up the mower and does the work for that week
 - Questions about what mower is appropriate, who should purchase it (town?), and who would be responsible for maintenance on equipment.
 - o Should volunteers be reimbursed by FWT for gasoline?
 - Passed by voice vote, effective immediately
 - ACTION ITEM: Norma to send email to mowers
 - o Establish subcommittee to identify plan
 - Identify an appropriate mower and what trails need to be mowed, confirm with what's in the mowing plan on the Website
 - Interview the Silver Foxes about their process
 - Write up proposal to share with Town
 - ACTION ITEM: Anna to ask Bud Gearhart to establish subcommittee
- Kiosk Information- Review how content is selected, when it is updated Group
 - Table until Craig is in attendance next month
 - Include discussion of a way to put something on the Website, such as a kids' corner

- Kiosk recommended contents: Maps, history, flora and fauna points of interest, and regulations
