B. Main Topics

- 1. WRNP: Mowing- Presentation from Guests describing how they approach mowing for their trails
- Victor Hiking Trails (VHT):1,233 members, 70 active volunteer list to draw from for Mowing mow approx. 35 miles of trails
 - VHT purchased their mowers- they own (3)
 - o Insurance costs- \$800-900 per year, paid by Town
 - Mowers stored by Trail Boss, he delivers them to locations of projects
 - o Maintenance of Mowers: annual, done my Trail Boss
 - They will take (3) mowers out, 3x per week
 - Volunteers rotate with availability
 - Crescent Trail Hiking Association (CTHA)- mow approx. 20 miles of trails
 - o Own (5) Billy Goats
 - CTHA purchased mowers
 - o Insurance Costs- \$800-900 per year, paid for by CTHA
 - Mowers stored in Town Shed (unheated, no power)
 - Town provides a driver and a truck to deliver the mowers where needed
 - o Mow 1x per week, 10-12 volunteers, (4) mowers at time
 - Town summer help assists

 - Potential for fund raising for Mowers

 - Trail Projects 2021:
 - Revocable Permit: WRNP property line and trail path still needs follow up from town – Town attorney is reviewing sample revocable permit used by Victor Hiking Trails, as provided by Anna and Hal, awaiting feedback
 - o Hickory Bark Deck Repair follow up Dead tree removal
 - Determined that (4) trees are problematic.
 - Ash tree at the entry- Ron and potential Work party proposed to take down this tree
 - The remains of the tree that fell on the platform- propose Glenn Morell to remove
 - Additional two trees to be coordinated with Glenn Morrell
 - ACTION ITEM: John & Craig to coordinate with Glenn Morrell
 - o 6/19 workday at FMCP address wet spots and build boardwalk
 - (8) participants- (3) new to Trail work with FWT
 - 84ft of new boardwalk installed! Great work, with a heavy lift project.
 - Discussed creating a separate email list of Trail volunteers to reach out to for these types of projects.
 - o July Work Party: Webster Thomas Cross Country Team, parents and athletes- Craig and Ron organizing, improving Blue, Orange and Black trails. Gravel and wheelbarrows provided by Town.
- 3. Kiosk Information- Review how content is selected, when it is updated Group
 - Kiosk contents to remain consistent: Maps, history, flora and fauna points of interest, and regulations
 - Trail related Projects from groups to be shared on FWT Website, such as a kids' corner and FWT Facebook page
