B. Main Topics

1. Trails Planning & Maintenance: -

- a. Maintenance: Planning Steve
 - o Mowing: Craig and Steve mowed the Blue Trail to the Brown Trail with the new Mower. It took 1.5-2hrs to mow approx. 8' width. Concluded that training will be needed for volunteers to use the mower, and to load the mower on and off a trailer, it is a physical job.
 - Storage: Craig reached out to Glenn M. at Parks and Rec (P&R) regarding building a shed to store the new mower on P&R lot. Glenn did not approve the request. ACTION ITEM: ALL – research New enclosed Trailer 5'x8' min size, lockable, to store the mower protecting it from potential theft and weather damage. Estimated cost \$5K.
- b. Trail Workday #4: Four Mile Creek, May 21, 2022 feedback: Successful with 11 participants.
- c. Trail Workday #5: M. Johnson Trail, June 18, 2022 Norma coordinating with Mary on type of plaque to commemorate the Mike and Mary for their donation of lad. It will be like the plaque at John Ungar. Proposing to install Benches at

- over looks and provide a center arch at the trail entry of the Hojack trail also similar to John Ungar Trail.
- d. Trail Workday #6: Four Mile Creek, July 16, 2022 2/3rd of the trail is complete, 1/3rd remaining. Scout to build New Bridge. Scheduled to pick up the materials 06/14. Joe Corona from the Webster Rotary will be joining us for this trail work day. ACTION ITEM: Hal to reach out to the Scout to make sure he has all the info he needs.

- f. Trail Kiosk Lyme disease Info: signs posted at Gosnell Big Woods, WRNP, and 4MCP
- g. Hojack Trail Update: Bud worked on locations of rebar and tracks infilling them with dirt- Thank you Bud for the great work and follow up.
- h. Lost and Found Basket: Bud proposed installing a lost and found basket at trail head locations, as people are placing items in the brochure boxes. Proposal to use the Lost and Found basket similar to that installed at WRNP as the model, moving forward. It is a wire basket Ron installed with a note regarding Lost and Found Items. ACTION ITEM: Dennis and Anna to follow up with Glenn for approval, given his interest in standardizing content and look of Kiosks.
- i. Hickory Bark: Boardwalk Surface- Norma: Concern from hiker emailed comments on slippery surface when the Board walk gets wet. We can add a sign noting "Caution - Slippery when Wet", location and type of sign TBD, to be coordinated with Trail Steward
- j. Trail Maps: update for M. Johnson and Eckler Properties: ACTION ITEM: Norma and Craig to coordinate with completing mapping with QGIS, and Anna to follow up with Chris McAlister for new signs

- a Update: Identified area in WRNP, off Blue trail, to remove invasives and plant Native Species- sign noting the work will be placed to identify the project and spark interest
