B. Main Topics

1. Goals/Priorities

- Trail Use Counting Sarah/John: Trail counter from International Road Dynamics Inc. is top contender at \$390. Town will need to know when and where to deploy this, and that it doesn't have a camera. Board approved purchase by voice vote up at a cost of up to \$500.
- Insurance Anna: Received quote, but it was missing some elements. It must include liability, auto, directors and officers. Once we receive a complete quote, we can compare that with other organizations.
- New Forms/Tracking Anna: **ACTION ITEM:** Anna and Sarah will meet to coordinate.
- Trail Projects Projects/Schedule Flyer for 2023: Anna still needs to update the flyer.
- New Volunteer/Member Form: No update
- Website updates Events/ Registration/Info Anna: Based on the online registration app that WHEN used, we are looking to add a registration plug-in to our Website. Anna will share information with Board.
- VP Position Anna: To generate possible candidates, Anna will develop a position description that could be distributed to the membership, and we can also look at recruiting someone who might have interest. ACTION ITEM: Anna to draft the VP description.

2. Trails Planning & Maintenance:

- Workday #3 Four Mile Creek Dennis, feedback: Good turn out for creating a new trail from Salt Creek Overlook to Red trail. Nine total volunteers in addition to Board members.
- Workday #4 Four Mile Creek, July 22 Dennis, plans: Town to deliver stone that will be spread by the Webster XC team.
- Scout Project Status Patrick/Dennis: Approximately 10 scouts completed all boardwalk and bench construction on July 8 and 9. Leftover materials were returned for refund of nearly \$500 to credit card account. ACTION ITEMS: Chris to work with Craig on refund. Dennis will ask Patrick to ask Brody for total volunteer hours.
- Stewards Vests for Identification, per P&R- Order status Anna: Order placed and they should be here the first week of August.
- Webster Arboretum request Anna: As noted above, the Arboretum wanted to collaborate to build a pergola. It could be a possible scout project, but it's not possible at this time.
- Kiosk Info from the P&R Anna: Parks and Rec will be refreshing all kiosks (except Gosnell) with new paint/stain. They would like all information to be refreshed/reprinted and standardized to include maps, history/information, park

rules, and upcoming events, printed on weather-proof material. **ACTION ITEM:** Denise to photograph existing kiosk materials to be put on Drop Box within the next 2 weeks.

3. Re-Tree Project: Sarah

- Status of plantings: For 2022 and 2023 plantings through June, it's a 4 percent mortality. Tree cages have bittersweet growing on them that will need to be monitored/removed.
- Nursery has ~125 plants to be moved to the field this fall. Locations for planting to be determined in late summer and proposed to Board.

- Webster Chamber of Commerce Meeting June 23, 2023 Anna report: Information was well received, with Anna and Parks and Rec presenting.
- Trees Along the Trail Challenge August 5th Dennis: Publicity flyer created, with the change to make it a self-guided hike to differentiate it from the scavenger hunts. 5 clues for each tree will be on a handout, with photos of the tree leaf/bark. Need to have volunteers to hand out clues/map; someone to hand out treats at the overlook; scoring table volunteers. Suggestion to have a gift card for the tree for the winners, for planting in the fall, instead of having the actual trees. ACTION ITEM: Sarah and Dennis will see if we can put some of the seedlings in the ReTree nursery.
- Fall Scavenger Hunt- Nov. 4th Chiyoda Trail Emily P.
- Hot Cocoa Hike on Nov. 4.

5. Open Space:

• Gary Woods Community Forrest – Hal: Final property transfer should happen before Fall. Trail building and a bridge will be needed, which would be appropriate for scout projects.

- Town of Webster grant money needs to be spent this year. Approximately \$2k still to be spent. **ACTION ITEM:** Hal to check to see if there are restrictions for what that can be spent on.
