# 2. Goals/Priorities

- 1. Trail Use Counting Sarah/John/All
  - Proposal: purchase Diamond Traffic Products \$550 plus tax
    - o **Approved** to spend up to \$700 on counter.
  - Set up and location must be approved by the town. Sign "Trail Counting in Process" will go on the kiosk.
  - Proposed locations:

- o Whiting Road Blue Trail north and south from Parking Lot
- o Gosnell Big Woods.
- o Hojack at Holt
- o Four Mile Creek at the first bridge
- 2. Membership Communication/Email Denise: Site 5 (the email/Website host company) has changed requirements, making it more difficult to use.
  - Working on using Mail Chimp for mail distribution, currently using free service level. **ACTION ITEM:** Denise will investigate the higher service level to see if we should move up a level.
  - Site 5 is still hosting the Webpage, which is paid through April 2025.
- Insurance Anna/Craig/Chris: Investigation continues, with updated quote to be uploaded to Dropbox. ACTION ITEM: Anna to upload quote and to pursue additional quotes.

- 7. FWT Powered equip & Tools Anna: Policy is that Friends prefers to own minimal equipment to minimize storage and maintenance costs.

#### 4. Re-Tree Project: Sarah

- 4. Have seen some mortality in WRNP near the smoke house, possibly from Black Walnuts there.
